**Student activity participation Policy**

**KSHSAA handbook**

**Rule 14 Article 2:** A student who is under penalty of suspension or whose character or conduct brings discredit to the school or to the student, as determined by the principal, is not in good standing and is ineligible for a period of time as specified by the principal.

Students participating in extra-curricular activities at Mulvane High School will be subject to the following guidelines.

Any student who, is in possession of alcohol, tobacco, prescription medication (other than that prescribed to that person by the label), or any illegal substance is considered in violation of rule 14 Article 2 of the Kansas State High School Activities Association. (See above)

Any student who, is at school, a school related function, a school related activity, or a school dance either during school hours or after the normal school day and is believed to be intoxicated, under the influence of alcohol or drugs by reasons/suspicious of smell, odor, behavior, in a conscious or unconscious state will be considered in violation of rule 14 Article 2 of the Kansas State High School Activities Association. (See above)

Any student who, is guilty of violation of a public law is considered in violation of rule 14 Article 2 of the Kansas State High School Activities Association (See Above)

Any student who, is found in possession of a weapon, gun, knife, explosive material, or items additionally listed in student handbook as forbidden at school, school functions, school activities, or a school dance either during school hours or after the normal school day will be considered in violation of rule 14 Article 2 of the Kansas State High School Activities Association.

Any student who, is ejected/disqualified or removed from a school activity, school function or school dance either during school hours or after the normal school day will be considered in violation of rule 14 Article 2 of the Kansas State High School Activities Association.

**Academic Eligibility**

All students must pass at least five new subjects (those not previously passed) last semester. (The KSHSAA has a minimum regulation which requires you to pass at least five subjects of unit weight in your last semester of attendance)

During the school year, student eligibility will be determined on Monday, and if a student does not meet grade requirements (no more than 1 failing grade), he/she will have the remainder of the week to meet grade requirements. If, on the following Monday, minimum grade requirements are not met, the student becomes ineligible to participate at that time until the grade requirements are met. Eligibility will be determined on a week – by- week basis starting with the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of each quarter.

The student and parent/guardian have read and understand the participation and eligibility guidelines for Mulvane High School Athletics and Activities.
