WHAT ARE WE LEARNING THIS WEEK?

Grammar —

We have learned the 5 parts of a letter. This week, students will practice writing a letter using correct placement of the heading, greeting, body, and closing.

Math - Geometry

Students will learn to describe objects by their length, weight, and capacity. Students will learn which parts, or *attributes*, of an object can be measured. Students will measure the length, width, and height of objects using standard (rulers) and nonstandard measuring tools. We will use cubes, paper clips, index cards, and our hands to measure the objects.



Social Studies—

We will have a review session this week for the **test on Thursday**. Students will review different landforms— island, peninsula, plain, etc. We will review continents and seasons. Ask to hear our continent chant. We will also review the Earth's natural resources, the changes we make to earth, and how we protect the Earth.
