Considered the first battle of the American Revolution.

The Battle of Lexington

Started when a group of colonial militiamen met British troops on Lexington's town green on April 19, 1775.

The British were marching from Boston to look for military supplies reportedly stored in Concord by local militias.

Other American colonists had given the militiamen advance notice of the British troop's march toward Lexington and Concord.
