Pittsburg State University

The Pittsburg State University Honors College is now accepting applications for the fall 2019 semester. Participation in the Honors College is limited to a select group of 30 academic scholars who receive Presidential, University, or Crimson and Gold Scholarships.

Criteria for application and potential selection for entering freshman include the following:

- 28 or higher composite ACT score (or SAT equivalent score of 1310);
- a minimum of 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale) college preparatory high school grade point average.

Twelve **Presidential Scholars** receive an academic scholarship of \$9,500 per year for four consecutive years with a one-time \$2,000 study abroad stipend for a total four-year package of \$40,000. Twelve **University Scholars** receive an academic scholarship of \$4,500 per year for four consecutive years with a one-time \$2,000 study abroad stipend for a total four-year package of \$20,000. Six **Crimson and Gold Scholars** receive an academic scholarship of \$1,000 for four consecutive years with a one-time \$2,000 study abroad stipend for a total four-year package of \$6,000.

The Honors College encourages academic success through a variety of honors sections of general education courses that foster a sense of community and purpose among students with academic records. During the junior-senior level, Honors College scholars are required to complete departmental honors. As an Honors College member, they will also receive the opportunity to enroll early for courses.

The deadline for submitting an application for the Pittsburg State University Honors College is **January 15**, **2019**. If you have high school seniors who meet the qualifications of 28 on the ACT and a 3.5 GPA, and are interested in our program, I recommend you have them begin making application to our Honors College.
