Chop Saw Safety

- 1. The chop saw has a 2" safety margin.
- 2. Always check the abrasive wheel for cracks before starting the machine.
- 3. Stand to the side of the wheel when in operation.
- 4. Allow the saw to reach full speed before cutting any material.
- 5. Aluminum should never be cut on the chop saw.
- 6. Never leave the saw unattended when running.
- 7. Always secure the work piece securely before cutting.
- 8. Never allow you hand to cross the line of the wheel.

Portable Grinder Safety

- 1. Be aware of where you are throwing sparks.
- 2. Never carry or unplug the grinder by the cord.
- 3. Always wear ear protection when grinding.
- 4. Always wear a face shield when grinding.
- 5. Allow the grinder to reach full speed before grinding.

Plasma Cam

- 1. Do not look at the torch when the machine is cutting.
- 2. Always test the torch before cutting.
- 3. Check all corners to ensure the torch will not move off the material.
- 4. Move the project as close as you can to the edge of the material to avoid wasting material.
- 5. Turn ventilation on before cutting.
- 6. Turn the auto cut on.
- 7. Check with instructor before starting cut.
- 8. Turn off and unplug the torch before changing consumables.
- 9. Do not lean or rest your hands on the cutting table.
