

CED Superintendent Communication with the Board

CED

The superintendent is responsible for providing timely information to the board concerning relevant student and personnel matters that could negatively impact the district and which are potentially matters of public concern.

If the superintendent has recused himself/herself or declared a conflict of interest in a matter that the board needs to be apprised of, the superintendent should advise the board of the conflict immediately and notify the board of the administrator handling the matter. After such notification is made, the designated administrator and the board of education should communicate directly to each other regarding the matter.

If the board of education deems further investigation is necessary, the board can request a neutral third party investigate the matter.
