The FAST Family Report answers three main questions parents have: How is my student doing? How does my student compare to his or her peers? And how have my student's scores changed over time?

PENNIES FOR PATIENTS

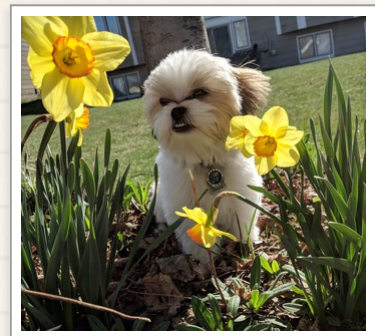

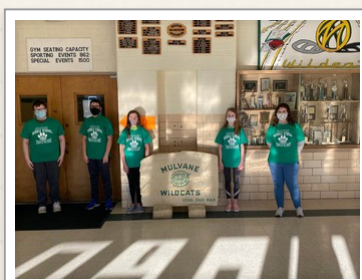
TRACK INFORMATION
