

**KANSAS SCHOOL FOOD PURCHASING ASSOCIATION**

**Invitation to Bid & VENDOR GUIDELINE CONTRACT**

**BID REQUEST 1-2020**

1. All items are to be ordered on an as needed basis.
2. Delivery schedules will be set and/or approved by each member school.
3. Food brokers must obtain membership information and listing of bid products, catalogs or bid winners lists from approved vendors. Member schools will make an effort to purchase other items not bid, from those vendors who are awarded bids for the current purchasing period.
4. **KSFPA will limit the bid award to the 2 vendors who have the highest dollar percentage of the bid. (Cases nor number of lines bid will not be relevant) All other vendors will be eliminated from the bid for the current bid year. Line items that were won by a vendor that was eliminated, will be reassigned to the lowest bid from the 2 vendors that won the bid.**
5. **Products must be received in accordance with HACCP guidelines. Refrigerated and frozen products must be kept at proper temperatures. Refrigerated products below 41 degrees and frozen products "frozen to touch". Products which do not meet these requirements will be refused.**
6. **Labels.** Vendors must supply the most current available nutritional data specifications and CN labels or product formulation statements for all main dish products which contribute to the meat/meat alternate component & grain/bread component of the meal pattern requirements after the vendor is awarded the bid. Examples of these products are beef patty, pizzas, meat or cheese, burritos, rolls, etc. Please call Jeanne Munsell 684-2090 with questions about CN labels,
7. **Vendors must be a full service company and bid on a majority of the items in the catalog.** Products must be Grade A. Products must be trans fat free. Products should be whole grain.
8. If vendors consistently substitute items, increase bid prices, charge more than the bid price, have unreliable deliveries, or present other problems for the member schools, they may be deleted from the bidding list for the next bidding period. The vendor can petition the Steering Committee to be allowed to bid for the next school year bidding period.
9. If a food service company currently on the vendor list for the KSFPA is sold, the membership of the association is under no obligation to honor bids from the seller.
10. Vendor must provide on line ordering for bid items & non-bid items.
11. Vendors must supply HACCP compliance statement to each member school.
12. Vendors must complete form 13-A Certification Regarding Debarment upon submission of bid.
13. Restocking charges for returned or refused items are not allowed.
14. The food service director- before the delivery- must approve substitutions.
15. No fuel/delivery charges will be permitted.
16. If bid prices escalate, proper documentation may be required from the manufacturer. Bid prices must be honored **4 weeks after the notification date**. Any item, which escalates in price, will be offered to the next lowest bidder or re-bid.
17. Distributor will supply rebate forms on all products as made available by manufacturers. Distributor will supply velocity reports as requested by the school districts.
18. Vendors must email school districts if any purchased products are recalled.

## **Additional Vendor procurement requirements and information**

**The KSFPA bid is a line item bid. The bid will be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder or bid/offer most advantageous to the program with price being the primary factor on each line. Price is the primary factor for the bid award.**

**Substitution** All items on the bid may be substituted with an item that is equal to the Manufacture ID on the bid. If an alternate product would be bid, other vendors will be allowed to provide a bid on that specific item as well.

### **Termination**

1. Material Breach: In the event either party commits a material breach, the non-breaching party may terminate this agreement for cause by giving sixty (60) days written notice. If the breach is remedied prior to the proposed termination date, the non-breaching party may elect to continue this agreement.
2. Notwithstanding the previously stated breaching provision, the Member Schools may terminate this contract for breach/neglect as determined by the Member Schools with written notification to the Vendor, in regard to such items as failure to maintain and enforce required standards of sanitation, failure to provide required periodic information/statements, or failure to maintain quality of service at a level satisfactory to the SPONSOR.
3. The CONTRACTOR and the SPONSOR may each terminate this agreement without cause by 30 days written notice to the other party of its intent to terminate.
4. The rights of termination in this agreement are not intended to be exclusive and are in addition to any other rights available to either party at law or in equity.

**Byrd Anti-Lobbying Amendment** (31 U.S.C. 1352)—Contractors who apply or bid for an award of \$100,000 or more shall file the required certification. Each tier certifies to the tier above that it will not and has not used Federal appropriated funds to pay any person or organization for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a member of Congress, officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a member of Congress in connection with obtaining any Federal contract, grant or any other award covered by 31 U.S.C. 1352. Each tier shall also disclose any lobbying with non-Federal funds that takes place in connection with obtaining any Federal award. Such disclosures are forwarded from tier to tier up to the recipient.

**Debarment and Suspension** (E.O.s 12549 and 12689)—All parties doing business with the Department of Agriculture should consult the Department's regulations for debarment and suspension found at 7 CFR 3017. No contract shall be made to parties listed on the General Services Administration's List of Parties Excluded from Federal Procurement or Nonprocurement Programs in accordance with E.O.s 12549 and 12689, "Debarment and Suspension." This list contains the names of parties debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded by agencies, and contractors declared ineligible under statutory or regulatory authority other than E.O. 12549. Contractors with awards that exceed the small purchase threshold shall provide the required certification regarding its exclusion status and that of its principal employees.

### **Buy American Provision**

1. As required by the Buy American provision, all products must be of domestic origin as required by 7CFR Part 210.21 (d).
2. Each Member School District participates in the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program and is required to use the nonprofit food service funds, to the maximum extent practical, to buy domestic commodities or products for Program meals. A "domestic commodity or product" is defined as one that is either produced in the US or is processed in the US substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the US as provided in 7 CFR Part 210.21 (d).
3. Exceptions to the Buy American provision should be used as a last resort; however, an alternative or exception may be approved upon request. To be considered for the alternative or exception, the request must be submitted in

writing to a designated official, a minimum of 10 day(s) in advance of delivery. The request must include the:

- a. Alternative substitutes(s) that are domestic and meet the required specifications:
    - i. Price of the domestic food alternative substitute(s); and
    - ii. Availability of the domestic alternative substitute(s) in relation to the quantity ordered.
  - b. Reason for exception: limited/lack of availability or price (include price):
    - iii. Price of the domestic food product; and
    - iv. Price of the non-domestic product that meets the required specification of the domestic product.
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## USDA Nondiscrimination Statement

**KSFPA Bid Substitution or Pack Change**

Vendors that substitute equal products or change pack size must put a note in the third column alerting the bid coordinator of the change in product.

Equal items - the vendor should type "**EQUAL**" in the column.

Different pack size - the vendor should type "**PACK**" in the column.

Items that are equal but a different pack size do not have to be included in the taste test.

(Example: 1 oz mozzarella cheese is packed 96 on the bid - If you are bidding 168 count just note PACK in the 3rd column we do not need a taste test)

EQUAL PRODUCTS must be equal to the item listed on the bid in ALL of the following criteria:

- Meat/meat alternate equivalent
- Grain/Bread equivalent
- Vegetable equivalent
- Fruit equivalent
- Cooking process (example: canned soup may only be replaced with canned soup..frozen soup requires a longer cooking time and is not interchangeable in all recipes)
- Nutritional Analysis - Many items are purchased for "Smart Snacks" and must be smart snack compliant for schools to sell the snack items.
- Taste - Vendors must plan a blind taste testing event to sample all substituted items. The event should be held 10-14 days before the bid is awarded. The president, bid coordinator and one coop member will attend the event. The vendor must offer the product bid and the product substituted for the panel to sample. The event will be held at the location of the vendors choice. Or the vendor may send the product requested and the product substituted to: Richard Hampton USD 263 Mulvane, 628 E Mulvane Street, Mulvane KS 67110. The following is the score sheet that will be used for either method:
- **Vendors must provide nutritional analysis and a CN Label or Product Formulation Statement at the taste test event for all items that are substituted or send the information requested with the samples.**
- The following is the score sheet that will be used for the taste testing event:
